Several accounts from freedom seekers mention sassafras as a food source. The sassafras tree is unusual for having five distinct leaf shapes. Here are some of the easiest to identify:



Take a walk and look at the shape of leaves.
Choose a leaf to take with you. When you get home, carefully write what freedom means to you on your leaf. A fine-tipped Sharpie works well for this.
Set your leaf free.
