**Master Naturalist Program Guidelines**

**Requirements:**

40 volunteer hours per year (Note: You may include travel time incurred in excess of 30 minutes for travel to and from your service site.)

8 Hours advanced training per year. This category does not count as volunteer hours.

**Descriptions of Approved Activities (not all inclusive):**

1. Educational activities: classes, workshops, presentations, demonstrations (including preparing and developing materials); phone consultations, posters, displays, articles, re
2. Stewardship Activities – hands-on activities to improve habitat & other natural resources (invasive plant removal, habitat restoration, trail building)
3. Citizen Science Activities – data collection, monitoring, biological inventories, other research-oriented activities (bird censuses, frog watch)
4. Special Events, Information Booths
5. Support/management activities (that benefit the public): planning programs and activities, for the public, outreach, publicity, set-up and clean-up, grant writing, evaluation
6. Internal Administration of Master Naturalist Program - All administrative work that directly benefits the MN program itself. For Example: screening applicants, organizing basic training, mentoring, hosting, communications (newsletter, website, phone tree), fundraising, public relations/marketing, advocacy, committee work, recordkeeping, writing reports, recognition of volunteers, etc.
